#### PURPOSE:

Peer Counselors need to enhance their clinical skills and understanding of the peer counselor's scope of practice when providing in-person breastfeeding. Many new peers were hired during the pandemic while virtual support was standard. In-person counseling skills are now needed to be developed as WIC services are moving back to an in-person environment.

#### LEARNING OUTCOME:

Peers will have knowledge to provide support for common breastfeeding concerns. Participants will know about the Clinical Summaries resource available through the USDA Curriculum and will know how to apply this resource when providing breastfeeding support. In addition, peers will have proper documentation skills (e.g., care plan development) and how to apply that in a clinical setting.
